UG Programmes: 5 years degree program - Bachelor of Architecture (B. Arch).

A. Choice Based Curriculum:

Following the curriculum of University, school provides choices through implementation of college projects & electives based on students choices in concurrence with the subject teachers.

B. Integrated Programmes and Projects:

The School proposes to take up live Architectural Projects to expose students & faculty to the practical project scenario continuously.

E. Credit Requirements:

The minimum credit required for award of a B. Arch degree is 340. Out of which 324 credits (36 credits x 9 semesters) are normally divided into theory courses, studios, electives, seminars and projects. Whereas 16 credits are granted for completion of professional practice of 16 weeks.

F. Evaluation of College Projects:

seminars, tutorials, additional classes for any course, guest lectures, exhibitions, workshops, participating in architectural competitions or conducting site visits or study tours.

G. Attendance:

As per the University ordinance 119,75% attendance is compulsory for keeping the term. It is compulsory for all theory, studio, seminar & project/dissertation.

H. Course Commencement:

Classes for 1st year of B. Arch course shall commence as per directives of DTE, COA & UoM.

Academic Process and Support Systems

• Program of study:

- a. The minimum duration of architectural program shall be 5 academic years or 10 semesters of approximately 16 working weeks each. It is inclusive of 6 months / 1 semester of approximately 16 working weeks of practical training after the first stage in a professional office.
- b. The architecture course is conducted in two stages.
 - i. The first 3 academic years comprising 6 semesters (approximately 16 working weeks each) is the 1st stage of the basic program. The candidates shall have to complete the first stage within 5 years of their admission to the B. Arch program.
 - ii. The second stage of the course shall be of 2 academic years/ 4 semesters (approximately 16 working weeks each).

GPA & CGPA

If class/division are not awarded, a minimum of 60% marks in aggregate shall be considered equivalent to first class/division OR in a grade point system the CGPA will be converted into equivalent marks as given in the table.

Semester End Examination:

The end of semester examination is mandatory. The grade for courses can be awarded only after successful completion of both Internal Assessment and End Semester Examination of the respective courses as per the scheme of the examination by:

- Faculty Advisors, Design Proctors and Student Proctors

General Instructions:

- 1. The reporting time for College is 7.45 A.M.
 - Instructional Timing is between 8.00 A.M. to 3.20 P.M. from Monday to Friday.
 - Academic load compensation & Practice Session may be arranged on Saturday / holidays.
- 2. Students should be regular and punctual for theory and practical sessions.
- 3. Minimum 75% attendance in each passing head is mandatory for term grant.
- 4. Attendance for participation/ conduct in extra and co-curricular activities will be granted as per institute norms.
- 5. In case of leave due to emergency or medical reasons application should be addressed to the Principal/Director for the leave-grant through class

in-charge.

- 6. The College web site should be visited regularly.
- 7. Assignments / Studio Work / Practical should be completed as per the schedule.
- 8. All important dates provided by examination section should be met without fail.
- 9. Cell phones are not allowed within the academic boundaries.
- 10. All facilities and amenities should be used judiciously.
- 11. Any illegal activity within the college premises is strictly prohibited.
- 12. Wearing ID-card in college campus is compulsory.
- 13. Formal dress code should be maintained (half pants, capris, sleeveless T-shirts are not allowed).
- 14. Discipline and decorum should be maintained within the College premises.
- 15. Consumption of alcohol, tobacco, drugs, cigarette smoking are prohibited in the institute campus. General awareness programs are conducted on regular basis.

Note: Apart from above mentioned rules other guidelines may be provided as and when required.

First Year B. Arch. admission application forms are available in the Administrative Office on payment of ₹ 1500 by cash.

Forms will be issued and accepted between 10.30 am to 4.00 pm from the date of notification in the newspaper.

Hostel:

Residence-cum-study facility is available for boys and girls in secured modern Hostel Buildings with green, clean and healthy ambience situated near the Institute.

Prevention & Prohibition of Ragging

Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999 which is in effect from 15th May, 1999 has the following provisions for Action against Ragging

- a) Ragging within or outside of any educational institution is prohibited
- b) Whomsoever directly or indirectly commits, participates, abets, or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institutional shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term upto 2 years and/ or penalty, which may extend to ₹10,000.
- c) Any student convicted of an offence of ragging shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal
- d) Whenever any student or, as the case may be, the parent or guardian or a teacher of an educational institution complaints, in writing, of ragging to the head of the educational institution, the head off the head of the educational institution shall, without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, within seven days of the receipt of the complaint, enquire into the matter mentioned in the complaint and if, prima facie, it is found true, suspend the student who is accused of the offence, and shall, immediately forward the complaint to the police station having jurisdiction over the area in which the educational institution is situated, for further action. Where, on enquiry by the head of the education institution, it is found that there is no substance, prima-facie, in the complaint received; he/she shall intimate the fact, in writing, to the complainant. The decision of the head of the educational institution shall be final.
- e) If the Head of the educational institution fails or neglects to act in the manner specified in section "d" above when a complaint of ragging in made, such person shall be deemed to have abetted the offence and shall, on conviction, be punished as provided for in section "b" above.

Ragging Prevention at TSAP

- Anti ragging squad is constituted as per AICTE guidelines
- Names, telephone nos. of authorities have been put on the website. In case of any emergency student can contact the authority or hostel warden
- Staff members do the necessary counseling from Time-to-time sensitize
- Surprise/routine visits to hostel, college canteen, common room & other sensitive area are done by the committee members

The provisions laid down by Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999 are followed by the institute which is displayed on the notice board.
