- h) Total Annual Income of Family / Guardian should not be more than Rs. 8,00,000/- Eight Lakhs.
- i) Minimum 75 % attendance in previous semester (Exception for fresh admitted in College).
- j) During course duration, candidate should not have a gap of 2 or more than 2 years.

2) Dr. Punjab Rao Deshmukh Hostel Maintenance Allowance Scheme. - 2024-25.
