MORE THAN 125 years ago, the architectural executive engineer to the Bombay Government, John Adams laid down the plans for the police headquarters in the city. Located right opposite Crawford Market, workon the Anglo-Gothic building started in 1894 and was completed in 1896.

For Dhanashree Goregaonkar, a 22-year-old restaurateur, the Office of the Commissioner of Police is reminiscent of the work done by her great-great-grandfa-ther, Harishchandra Jagannath

Goregaonkar. Harishchandra and his team Harishchandra and his team carried out the actual construc-tion of the office, based on Adam's designs. A plaque inside the com-missioner's office at an ornate staircase, solely used by the Commissioner of Police, attests to this little regarded detail and credits "Harishchundra Juggannath Contractor" for exe-cuting the plan.

As it turns out, the contractor built more than just this iconic structure; he is connected with the city's chawls and bungalows.

One is Harishchandra Smriti, also commonly referred to as the green burgalow, the family home where he lived. Beside it is a taller building, built by his son, solicitor Krishnarao, which served as a stu-

krighmaran, which served as a su-dio for later generations. This one has "Coregaoleer Bros" Art Studio" emblazoned on its facade. Growing up in Harishchandra Smeit, Dhanashare wasn't always aware of her family's history. "We have a bust of my great-great-examifather in our binder soon grandfather in our living room and as a child, I thought it was Lokmanya Tilak. I often won-dered why we have him in our house. It was only years later that I realized he was our arcestor and that he has contributed a lot to the

"We mostly see credits to British architects but not native contractors, who were crucial in sourcing material and labour. Harishchandra was one such Harishchandra was one such person. He started by making furniture and there is evidence that shows he built police chowkis, such as the one at Pythonie, and the annexure of the Nagpada police station. The police commissioner's office was his first big break, so to say, after making the police of police police of police polic

He added that Harishchandra also built the interiors of railway stations and laid the tracks for the Great Indian Peninsular Railway (GIPR) in Bombay and Bombay. Baroda and Central India (BBCI)

Raifway. Dahisarkar, an Indologist and Dahisarkar, an Indologist and art historian, carme across Harischandra in relation to a Ram temple in Oshiwara, the one that lends its name to the railway station, Ram Mandir. The temple was built in 1835, though Dahisarkar said it's not clear who built it.

By the last years of the 19th century, the bubonic plague had the city in its clutches and the temple fell into disase and disrepair. Dahisarkar's research shows that the temple was repaired through

the temple was repaired through the efforts of Harishchandra and his brother, Bhikoba, He also initi-ated a Ram Navami celebration

with his funds. Harishchandra was refor his scope of work, which ranged from commissioned projects for the British government to housing projects that he undertook.




FLOOR PLAN (PROPOSED HOUSING AT ANDRERS, SEEPZ)
