Admission Notice FOR CAP STUDENTS

Reporting for First Year Degree Architecture

1. Students must report to the Institute *between August 05th 2017 to August, 08th 2017 (10am to 5pm)* as per DTE schedule. (Please check the website www.dtemaharashtra.gov.in)
2. Students should register online at University of Mumbai website at <http://mum.digitaluniversity.ac> and bring final print out with them when reporting for admission.
3. Students must submit original documents plus four sets of photocopy of the documents as per their category. (List of documents attached)
4. All photo copies should be self-attested by the candidates.
5. Students should bring 4 passport size photographs on white background of themselves for the Admission form.
6. Students should report to the college along with Demand Draft (any Bank) of the fees applicable for their category (**See attached Fee table**)
7. Demand Draft should be made in favour of **“Thakur School of Architecture & Planning”** Payable at **Mumbai**
8. **All Students are required to purchase Admission form of the Institute. Admission form fee is Rs.1500/-**

Note:

1. OBC, SBC, VJ, NT & DT category candidates must produce Income certificate at the time of admission signed by the competent authority showing total annual income below Rs 6,00,000/- to claim fee concession.
2. This fee already excludes Rs 4000/- (For **Open/OBC/ NT/SBC/VJ/DT**) for amount which has already been paid at ARC.
3. As per G.R. if Income is more than 6 lakh p.a. students are not eligible for scholarship, they are required to pay Open category fee (Applicable for OBC, SBC, VJ, NT & DT category students)
